Carry out Initial Steps			
Feedback			
Puts on gloves			
Feedback			
Lifts resident's gown to expose catheter area			
Feedback			
<b>Checks to see that urine can flow, unrestricted, into the drainage bag, verbalize</b>			
Feedback			
Uses a washcloth with soap and water to carefully wash around the catheter where it exits the urethra			
Feedback			
<b>Holds catheter where it exits the urethra with one hand</b>			
Feedback			
<b>While holding the catheter tubing with fingers where it exits the urethra, cleans 4 inches down the catheter tube</b>			
Feedback			
<b>Cleans with stroke(s) only away from the urethra</b>			
Feedback			
Uses a clean portion of a washcloth			

for any strokes			
Feedback			
Rinses using stroke(s) only away from the urethra			
Feedback			
Rinses using clean portion of a washcloth for any strokes			
Feedback			
Pats dry			
Feedback			
Does not allow the tube to be pulled at any time during the procedure			
Feedback			
Replaces top cover over resident and leaves resident in a position of safety and comfort

Places a barrier on the floor under the drainage bag			
Feedback			
Places the graduate on the previously placed barrier			
Feedback			
Opens the drain to allow the urine to flow into the graduate			
Feedback			
Completely empties drainage bag			
Feedback			
Avoids touching the graduate with

any part of the tubing			
Feedback			
Closes the drain			
Feedback			
<b>Wipes the drain with alcohol wipe AFTER emptying drainage bag</b>			
Feedback			
Replaces drain in holder			
Feedback			
Places graduate on level, flat surface			
Feedback			
With graduate at eye level, reads output			
Feedback			
Empties, rinses and dries (with a clean, dry paper towel) equipment			
Feedback			
Returns equipment to storage			
Feedback			
Records output on the previously signed recording form			
Feedback			
<b>Candidate's recorded output measurement is within 30ml's of the RN Test Observer's output reading</b>			
Feedback			
Removes gloves turning inside out and dispose gloves in the designated container (trash can)
