

## Checklist: Put on and Remove PPE - Goggles/Face Shield

<b>Put on PPE - Goggles/Face Shield</b>	<b>Able to Perform</b>	<b>Unable to Perform</b>
1. Perform hand hygiene using soap and water or an alcohol-based hand sanitizer before handling eye protection.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
2. Select the appropriate goggles or face shield based on the required level of splash or exposure protection.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
3. Inspect the goggles or face shield for cracks, scratches, loose parts, or damage. Do not use defective equipment.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
4. Ensure the eye protection is clean and free of debris that may obstruct vision.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>

1. Perform hand hygiene if hands are visibly contaminated before removing eye protection.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
2. Avoid touching the front surface of the goggles or face shield, as it is considered contaminated.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
3. Remove goggles by handling only the headband, earpieces, or side arms.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
4. Remove a face shield by handling only the rear headband or strap.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
5. Pull the goggles or face shield away from the face carefully without touching the skin or eyes.	<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>
