

Skills Checklist: Giving/Receiving a Urinal

Carry out Initial Steps			
Feedback			
Assemble equipment: -Urinal -Basin -Soap -Washcloth -Towel -Disposable gloves			
Feedback			
Put on gloves. Lift the top bedcovers and place the urinal under the covers so the patient can grasp the handle. Instruct the patient to place his penis in the urinal opening. If he cannot do this, you must position the urinal and place the penis in the opening			
Feedback			
Remove gloves and dispose of them properly. Wash your hands. Make sure the signal cord is within easy reach. Leave the patient alone if possible. Watch for his signal			
Feedback			
Answer the signal promptly. Put on gloves. Ask the patient to hand the urinal to you. Cover it			
Feedback			
Rearrange the bedclothes if necessary. Fill a basin with warm water (105°F), and place it next to soap, washcloth, and towel so the			

patient can wash and dry his hands			
Feedback			
Take the urinal to the bathroom or utility room and observe the contents. Measure, if required. Do not empty the urinal if you observe anything unusual (such as blood). Save the contents of the urinal for the nurse's inspection			
Feedback			
Empty the urinal. Rinse the urinal with cold water and clean it with warm soapy water. Rinse, dry, and cover the urinal. Remove gloves and dispose of them properly. Wash your hands

Place the urinal inside the patient's bedside table. Clean and replace other articles
