

## 12.) RE-POSITION A CLIENT ON THEIR SIDE IN THE BED

	Knock on the door.	
	Perform hand hygiene. a. Cover all surfaces of hands with hand sanitizer. b. Rub your hands together until they are completely dry.	
	Explain the procedure to the client.	
	Provide privacy- pull the curtain.	
	Position the bed flat.	
	Raise the bed to a comfortable working height.	
	Ensure that the client's face never becomes obstructed by the pillow. <b>*(counts double if missed)</b>	
	Assist/turn the client to turn onto their side. <b>*(counts double if missed)</b>	
	<b>Assist/turn the client to turn onto the correct side as read to them in the scenario.</b>	
	Check to be sure the client is not lying on their arm.	
	<b>Maintain the client's correct body alignment.</b>	
	Place support devices under the client's head.	
	Place support devices under the client's top arm.	
	Place support devices behind the client's back.	
	Place support devices between the client's knees.	
	Lower bed.	
	Lower side rail, if it was used.	
	Maintain respectful, courteous interpersonal interactions at all times.	
	Leave the call light or signaling device within easy reach of the client.
